Sewage Disposal (University of Samarra)

Description:

The University of Samarra Network Project is linked to the Samarra Sewage Project, which is being implemented under the supervision of the Ministry’s General Directorate of Sewage. It was built on a land area of (50 Acres), and includes heavy water and rainwater drainage networks, conveyor lines and lifting stations linked to the central treatment plant, which has a design capacity of (56,000). (m3/with the central processing unit, connecting residential floor subscriptions, and excavation work at lifting stations.) .Samarra Sewerage Company takes all necessary measures to cleanse and maintain those sewers (and any lateral drain) to ensure that the area that they serve is effectively drained.

There is also a duty to make provision for the emptying of those sewers, normally through sewage treatment works, or where appropriate, through discharges direct to watercourses.
