Description:

The University of Samarra is committed to improving sustainable transportation practices and enhancing traffic management within the campus. The university continuously works on redesigning parking areas to improve traffic flow efficiency and accommodate a larger number of vehicles. Efforts are also directed toward reducing the dependence on private cars by encouraging the use of public transportation and environmentally friendly mobility solutions.



The university promotes cycling among students and staff as an alternative transportation method instead of relying on private vehicles. Future development plans include studying the possibility of constructing multi-level parking facilities and underground parking areas to optimize land use and reduce congestion.

In addition, the university considers flexible work arrangements, including dividing staff working hours into different shifts to decrease traffic density during peak times and maximize parking capacity. Awareness initiatives are also encouraged to promote car-sharing among individuals living in the same residential areas in order to reduce the total number of vehicles entering the campus.

To support sustainable mobility, the university seeks to provide free bicycles for use within the campus and improve cycling-friendly infrastructure.

Current Sustainable Transportation Practices:

1. Limiting parking areas designated for students.
2. Providing free bicycle rental services within the campus.
3. Supporting ride-sharing and carpooling initiatives to encourage healthy and sustainable transportation options.
